



PREGNANCY HELP ORGANIZATIONS

Heartbeat's affiliate pregnancy help organizations (PHOs) support women wherever they are in their pregnancy journeys and beyond. Our affiliates fall into several categories according to the primary services they offer.



ABORTION TREND

According to Advancing New Standards in Reproductive Health (ANSIRH) at the University of California, there were 758 brick-and-mortar abortion facilities in the U.S. in 2020, and that decreased to 741 in 2023. However, by 2023, 226 new virtual abortion clinics had opened. **That makes 967 total places women could access abortion in 2023—more than any point in the past decade.**

Number of Brick-and-Mortar Facilities vs. All Facilities (including both Brick-andMortar and Virtual Clinics), by Year 1.




- Abortions rose from 930,160 in 2020 to over 1 million in 2023
- Reported telehealth abortions accounted for 20% of all U.S. abortions by mid-2024
- Mail-order pill websites like Plan C and Aid Access make it increasingly difficult to track abortion numbers accurately as they are not required to report




Since last year, there has been a **172% increase in pregnancy help** organizations offering telehealth or telecare—growing from 46 to 125 in just one year.







Option Line's 24/7 pregnancy helpline provides vital services, especially when pregnancy centers are closed. It ensures that assistance is available around the clock, offering support to women in need, particularly in times when alternative options like abortion pills by mail are being considered.





Hotline phone calls have risen from 48% of connections in 2022 to 64% in 2024, underscoring the growing need for direct human support during a perceived crisis.



OF WORLDWIDE ABORTIONS OCCUR IN THE UNITED STATES






APPROACHING AN AVERAGE NUMBER OF 2000



What's the trend?

- In 2025, an estimated 79% of abortions in the U.S. may be via the abortion pill.
- In 2030, the model projects 127%, which suggests a saturation point approaching 100%, meaning nearly all abortions could be chemically-based.
